Standards and formats for submitting your work:

The abstracts: should contain between 300 and 600 words, in Letter format (8.5"x 11"), a space and a half, Arial font (12 points), Microsoft Word or PDF. Include title, author, e-mails, institutions and abstract. It is suggested to include the summary in Spanish and English.

The final papers: maximum 12 pages, in Letter format (8.5"x 11"), a space and a half, Arial font (12 points), Microsoft Word or PDF. Include title, author, e-mails, institutions, abstract, introduction, development of the main ideas, conclusions and references.

The event's official languages are Spanish and English.

All selected works will be published in the memories of the event, on a CD-ROM with its ISBN.

Forms of presentation: Lectures, Presentations, Poster, Round tables, Software, Multimedia.

Important dates:

Register to participate in the seminar: From November 1, 2008 to January 10, 2009. You must send by e-mail your personal data: name, e-mail, institution, country, tentative title of your work, category of participant (student, delegate or observer).

Deadline for abstracts: Until January 10, 2009.

Deadline for final papers: Until February 5, 2009. The works received after this date are not guaranteed to be published in the proceedings of the seminar.
